Why do you want a place in the Aspiring Performers Academy – Dance Strand?

Acceptance into the Junior Aspiring Performers Academy (APA) Dance strand is by audition only. The two-year course focuses on each individual student's progression in technical and performance skills. Emphasis is placed on self-reflective practice and targeted training of core technique.

The program objective is to deliver studio style dance training by including ballet and jazz syllabus work. Students in Years 7 and 8 study the Australian Conservatoire of Ballet syllabus and Year 9 – 12 students study the Commonwealth Society of Teachers of Dancing Modern Jazz Syllabus for one lesson each week and suitable candidates can sit for exams. Students also gain an understanding of anatomy including the latest research on mobility and the importance of fascia in safely achieving increased flexibility.

All students involved in the program perform in front of a live audience at various performance events.
