

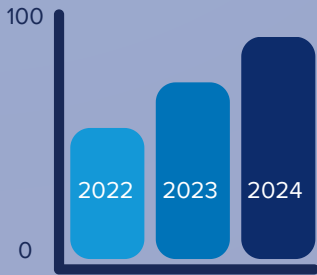


What is Positive Behaviour for Learning?

Positive Behaviour for Learning is a whole school framework that promotes positive behaviour across our college. PBL helps create safe and supportive learning environments by explicitly teaching the expected behaviours taking a pro-active, preventative approach to ensure all students receive the appropriate level of support to help them be successful at school.

What have we achieved?

Over the course of the year, we have completed multiple stages of staff wide feedback regarding PBL in our school.
