


The CANON


Students who are chosen to participate in The Canon Academy will find the content beneficial to complete their subjects in Senior School.

Students will engage with innovative and thought-provoking curriculum to question their understanding of the world and become highly articulate communicators.




READING Students must have a strong passion for reading and be capable of making meaning of the diverse opinions presented in texts. They will read and engage with a variety of novels, and expected to journal their reading experiences to share with peers and their teacher. Students who are not avid readers would find this component challenging.

The content is designed to be challenging, engaging, historically relevant and requires students to connect content, personal reflections and knowledge meaningfully.



WRITING Students will require a keen desire to write and respond creatively to tasks. This will require diligence, creativity, motivation and an ability to respond positively to feedback. Students will be expected to challenge ideas, share opinions, empathise and express their ideas stylistically through writing. They must be confident communicators that have a flair for experimenting with the writing process as they explore a variety of writing genres.

Students who are passionate communicators, creative thinkers, problem solvers and enjoy debating topical issues would excel in this subject.



SKILLS The course will support inquisitive students who are interested in events that have shaped history. As part of The Canon Academy, students will be using inquiry processes and design thinking to make sense of our current world. Students should be willing to question decisions made throughout history and present this information in new and engaging ways.
