

 Centrepay is a free direct bill paying service available to customers who receive an Australian Government Department of Human Services Centrelink payment, family assistance payment or Parental Leave Payment.

The college is able to supply the paperwork required by the Department of Human Services and it's delivery to the department OR the parent/s is able to apply online to register direct bill payments by using the following link <http://www.humanservices.gov.au/customer/forms/sa325>

This service is only available for the payment of the College's Student Resource Scheme and/or the Student Laptop Program and/or BYOD Program. Subjects and extra-curricular activities are not available to be used with Centrepay payment plans at this college. These items require separate payment via credit card, direct debit or payment in person options. These payments are offered by the Department of Human Services on a lump sum or fortnightly plan in conjunction with the scheduled government payment calendar. Parent/s are able to opt out of this service, suspend this service or change the deduction amount. The College is notified of any changes and will adjust the students payment file accordingly.

- Account number is your child's name
- Select the amount and frequency
- Add a target amount if you want the payments to stop at a certain amount otherwise it can continue to accrue on your child's account once invoices are paid in full.
- Ensure the payment deduction is clear (eg: FTB or pension)
- Don't forget to sign on the back page

Deductions at this College start from a minimum of \$20 per fortnight, per invoice, per child. Payments need to be in line with the College payment calendar due dates and minimum deductions may vary depending on the enrolment date for your child. Centrelink does not cover laptop deposits.
