Pimpama State Secondary College's Student Transitions to External Pathways (STEP) program is a unique education program aimed at Year 11 or 12 students who want to fast track their senior studies. STEP offers students an opportunity to complete their QCE via Vocational Education & Training (VET), while supporting transition into employment or external study. It is an accelerated senior education program, that sees students graduate after one year and transition into fulltime employment or post-secondary study.
