Pimpama State Secondary College's Student Transitions to External Pathways Program (STEP) is a unique and flexible education program aimed at Year 11 or 12 students who want to fast track their senior schooling. STEP offers students an opportunity to complete their QCE via a Vocational Education & Training (VET) pathway, while supporting the transition into employment or further external study. It is an accelerated 'one-year' senior phase of learning program. Students graduate after one year with the expectation of transitioning into employment, further training or study.


